yaksas(夜叉) (P.327, first line): A devil.

raksasha (羅刹) (P.327, first line): A cannibal.

Putana (富単那), krtya (吉シャ), Kumbhanda (鳩般荼) (P.327, first line): kinds of devils

**Vetada (毘陀羅)** (P.328, L.7 from the bottom): a red color devil.

kumbhanda (ケン駄) (P.328, L.7 from the bottom): a yellow color devil.

umaraka (鳥摩勒伽) (P.328, L.7 from the bottom): a black color devil.

apasmaraka (阿跋摩羅) (P.328, L.7 from the bottom): a blue color devil.

yaksakrtya (夜叉吉シャ) (P.328, L.7 from the bottom): a devil looked like a yaksas.

humankrty (人吉シャ) (P.328, L.6 from the bottom): a devil looked like a human being.

Truth of birthlessness (不退転) (P.329, last line): a stage of attainment from which one never retrogresses.
