Izu Persecution and Mother's Day Service May 21st, <u>10:30 a.m.</u> (Sun)

On May 12, 1261 Nichiren Shonin was arrested and exiled to Izu Peninsula under the indictment of disturbing the government. Instead of being dropped off on land, he was left on a rock in the bay. As the water rose, he was saved by a fisherman.

This event is considered to be the second of four major persecutions. Nichiren realized that he was living the Lotus Sutra. Let us commemorate this occasion remotely so that we too can live the Lotus Sutra.

We will also commemorate Mother's Day a week late. We cannot forget our mothers. Nichiren Shonin always stressed filial piety and to show gratitude towards one's parents. Let us also show our respect to our parents, especially to all mothers on her special day a week late. And let us not forget our fathers on Fathers Day, June 18th.

Triple World

In a recent Lotus Sutra study class on Chapter 16, I was asked to explain what the Triple World was. The Triple World consists of the realm of Desire, Form, and Formless. Let us investigate each one.

Desire: This is the world where there is appetite for food and sex. This is where humans reside and continually return because of their karma.

Form: This is a world without the trappings of desire which individuals have left behind but are still bound by material restrictions. Also, things such as rock and metal are considered to be Form.

Formless: This world has no substance or physical form, like the spiritual realm. They have transcended both Desire and Form.

The Triple World can each be divided into subcategories within each world. To explain it all will be time consuming so instead, I will try to simplify the explanation.

First, let us examine each of the three worlds in a different way. Desire is like the earth. It has a physical form from the mountains to the sea to the living beings contained. Form is like the atmosphere. The elements of "air" range from nitrogen to oxygen to carbon dioxide. We cannot see these elements and these elements do not have desire, but they still have a physical structure. Formless is like the sky. What is the sky? Can we really describe it? It has no substance, just a perceived appearance.

All three, earth, atmosphere, and sky are part of our existence. We can travel between each level when we concentrate our minds, but also when we pass through the cycle of birth and death. We are constantly trying to create good karma through accumulation of merits to reach the next subsequent level. We also can move backwards as well when we create conditions of bad karma.

⇔ So, even though we may have reached highest⇔ world of Formless, we are still bound by the cycles of birth and death. In Lotus Sutra Chapter Three, "Parables,"

The Triple World is not peaceful. It is like the burning house. It is full of sufferings. It is dreadful.

Because we are still too attached to the trappings of the Triple World, we continue to think that there is no escape.

But in the *Parable*, Buddha offers a way out using the teaching of the Three Vehicles (*Sravaka*, *Pratyekabuddha*, and Bodhisattva) to escape the burning house. However even when we think there are three paths, in actuality there is only the One Vehicle (everyone is a Buddha). Out of Buddha's compassion, He teaches us according to our capacities. For us believers in the Lotus Sutra, we can skip the Three Vehicles and concentrate only on the One Vehicle.

By our continued faith in Buddha's Teaching, we can escape bonds of birth and death and attain the

Enlightenment of the Buddha. Through the continued practice and studying the Lotus Sutra, we can realize the Buddha within ourselves. Each time we chant Odaimoku, we are building a spaceship piece by piece so that we can leave the confines of earth, atmosphere, and sky (Triple World). We can escape the gravitational pull of worldly matters and blast off into space where we can be free and view the world just like the Buddha.
